

Gift Holder Instructions

1. Using the DSP (designer series paper) of your choice from Stampin' Up!, cut a perfect square. I recommend 6x6" for a gift card holder, and any size up from that for a small gift holder. (8x8, 10x10, 12x12") I used [Traditions of Christmas paper](#).
2. Next you are going to make a fold on the diagonal. (For a good fold, use the [bone folder](#) that is sold in my online store.)
3. Using a pencil and ruler, or some kind of grid, make a mark at 3" where the flaps meet on each side of your folded triangle. (Note: whatever size square you are using, mark the fold line at half the size of the paper. For 10x10, you would mark at 5")
4. Fold at the two lines you just made.
5. Finally, fold down the center flap.
6. Stamp an image or sentiment on some cardstock, and place it over the folded down part, and embellish it however you wish.
